ABOUT THE DISTRICT:

The District traces its roots back to before 1900 when its Glendale school building located at 930 Congress Avenue was built. The District now consists of 36 square miles in the north central part of Hamilton County, encompassing the villages of Glendale, Evendale, Woodlawn and Lincoln Heights, and, the cities of Springdale and Sharonville. It encompasses a small portion of Butler and Warren counties. The school community is a desired area to reside in due to its location on the I-75 corridor in Southwest Ohio. The District consists of eight elementary schools (Pre-K–5), one middle school (6–8), one innovation center (6-12) and one high school (9–12). Princeton students also have the opportunity to attend the Great Oaks Joint Vocational School for specialized vocational and technical training.

The District is accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools. The District offers comprehensive academic curriculum through the following programs: college preparatory classes, advanced placement courses, International Baccalaureate, College Credit Plus, STEM, gifted education, vocational programs and a full range of services in special education. The District also provides tutorial help, resource rooms, speech/language therapy, psychological services and counseling, and mental health support. In addition to academic and related services, students have the opportunity to participate in a wide range of extra-curricular activities for all.
